The GEM Project is a local group of young people with a mission to spread messages of hope and endurance to students in the Dayton area. GEM stands for *Goal: Everyone Matters,* and our mission is to spread awareness about suicide prevention. Suicide is the 2<sup>nd</sup> leading cause of death in youth aged 10 to 34, and our team wants to change this statistic.

We are launching our 2<sup>nd</sup> Art Contest for Suicide Prevention on October 10<sup>th</sup>, World Mental Health Day, and we hope your students will participate. The contest is **open to youth in grades 6 - 12** and students will use their creativity to convey a message of hope to encourage other students who may be struggling with thoughts of suicide. Students will submit artwork that will be judged, and the top 10 winners will receive a total of \$5,000 in cash prizes. The winning artwork will be used to create banners, posters, social media posts, notecards, and possibly murals to encourage kids to keep on going.
